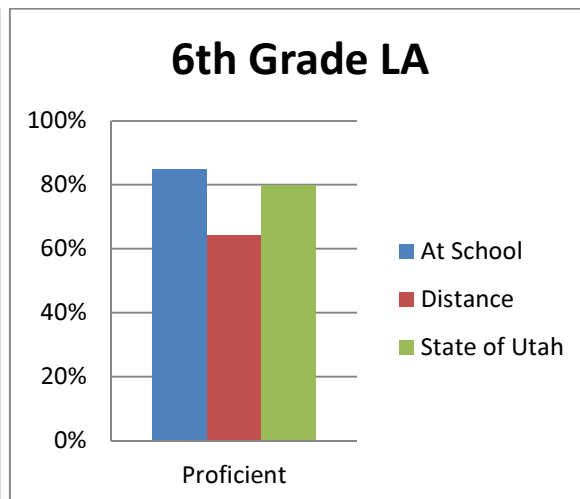
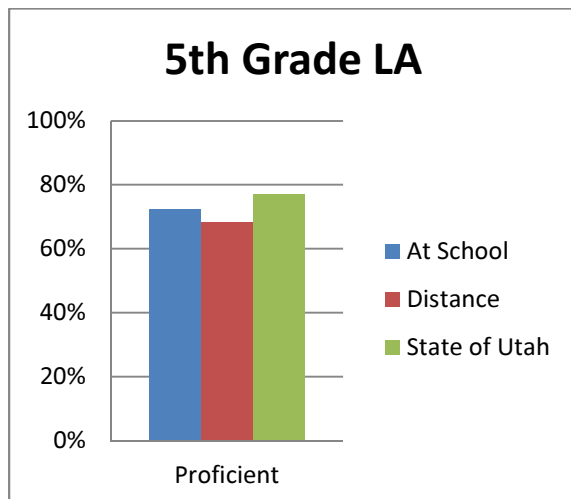
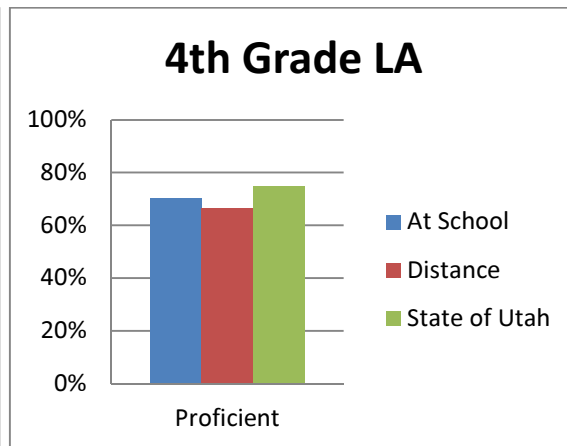
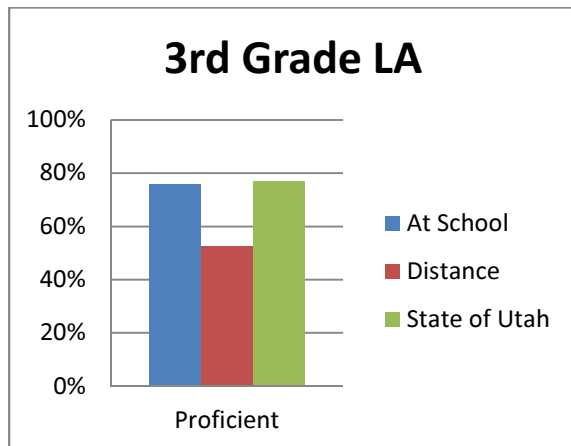


Student Achievement Language Arts 2010-2011

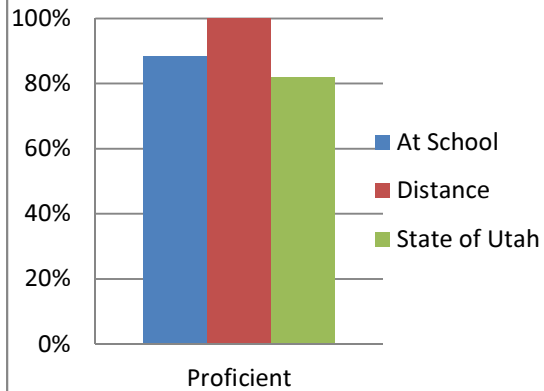
CRT Data Language Arts:

Liberty Academy partnered with Harmony Education group in the 2010-2012 school year. Harmony is a homeschool program that offers extension classes a couple days a week for students looking to enrich their homeschool experience. Liberty required that all students to complete the CRT state testing, at the end of the year. Unfortunately, some of the students and teachers did not put the correct code on their information and so most of the data was combined with the data gathered about students who attended classes daily in the regular school population. We have separated the test scores according to the school programs as shown in the graphs below. Those listed as distance students are those who were harmony students or come for a few days a week at the school. The following are scores from each grade level in Language Arts.

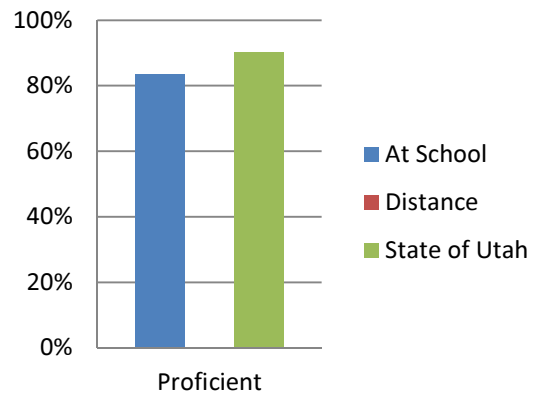
In the elementary grades those from the distance or homeschool/Harmony population are much less proficient until the 7th grade and 10th grade. There were only 1-2 students testing in each of these grades. Overall, Liberty was below the average state proficiency in Language Arts by 4%, and the distance or homeschool students were 19% below the state average for the 2010-2011 school year.



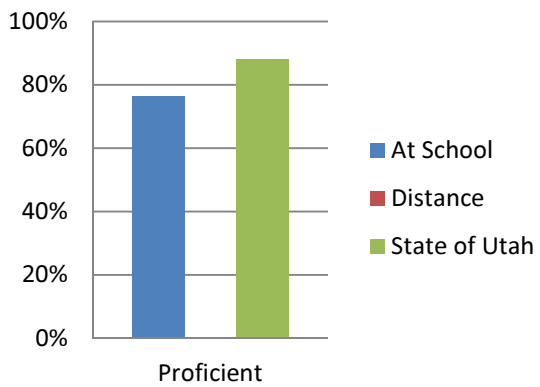
7th Grade LA



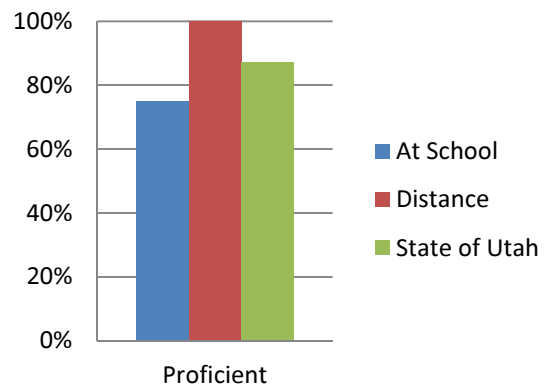
8th Grade LA



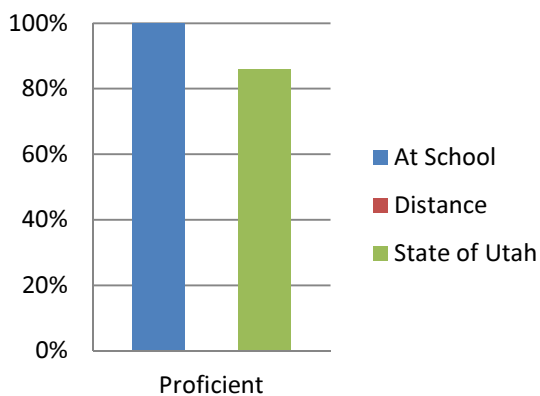
9th Grade LA
